

# Woolwich Swim Team Safety Information for Participants

Updated December 2021



The Woolwich Swim Team is committed to protecting the health and safety of all our participants. Please review the following COVID-19 procedures prior to your first practice.

## COVID-19 Vaccination Policy

- The Woolwich Swim Team requires that participants aged 12 and older be fully vaccinated for COVID-19 (including swimmers, coaches and volunteers). Swimmers will provide proof of vaccination at the time of registration.
- Effective December 20, 2021, the Ontario Provincial Government also requires proof of vaccination for anyone aged 12 and older participating in organized sports at recreational facilities. **Anyone entering the Woolwich Memorial Centre aged 12 and older will need to show proof of vaccination along with personal identification showing name and date of birth:**
  - Effective January 4, 2022, the enhanced vaccine certificate with QR code must be used for proof of vaccination. The QR code can be used digitally or by printing a paper copy. Individuals can download their enhanced certificate with QR code by visiting <https://covid-19.ontario.ca/book-vaccine/>.
  - Examples of personal identification include: birth certificate, health card, driver's licence, passport, permanent resident (PR) card, Indian Status Card or Indigenous Membership Card.

## Attendance & Health Screening

- The Woolwich Swim Team will use the provincial school and child care health screening for our participants. You must complete the screening the day you come to practice.

  - **Only attend practice if your swimmer has a 'Green Check'.**
- Attendance will be taken at each practice. It is **NOT** necessary to inform us if a swimmer will miss practice.

## Spectators

- Woolwich Swim Team spectators may enter the Woolwich Memorial Centre under the following conditions:
  - Spectators 12 and older must be fully vaccinated for COVID-19 to enter the WMC. You will be asked to show your proof of vaccination upon entry.
  - Spectators can complete the health screening required by the WMC prior to entering the WMC (<https://qr.groundlevelinsights.com/qrForm/template/3914>) or complete the screening form available when you enter the WMC.
  - Spectators must maintain physical distancing and wear a mask while in the WMC.
  - Spectators will not be allowed on the pool deck or viewing area inside the pool.
